- Help to improve the visual merchandising in the store.
- Help to raise money to help transform the lives of homeless people.

- Be friendly and approachable. Over 18.
- Work well using your own initiative and as part of a team.
- Previous experience of design, styling or retail would be beneficial but not essential.
